7. Letterlik en figuurlik van soortname	Ensure that the words are physically possible to be <b>letterlik</b> . If there is a form of personification it will be <b>figuurlik</b> .	7
8. Onderwerp, gesegde en voorwerp	You must be able to identify a subject (onderwerp), verb (werkwoord) and object (voorwerp) in a sentence.	7
9. Samestellings	You must be able to identify the compound word (samestelling) in the sentence by looking for a Stam 1 + Stam 2 = new word. See summary.	8
10. Sinonieme	Look for them in the summary and study only them: Vind; boot; lyf; slim; plek;	8
11. Punt, komma, uitroepeteken, vraagteken	<b>Vraagteken:</b> Know how to write a question and use fitting punctuation.	
12. Trappe van vergelyking	Trappe van vergelyking = degrees of comparison. Study the exceptions. <b>Jonk</b> (remember the rule about kill the king and send him to his grave + er) <b>goed</b>	10
